Lesson Title:	Discover what Facebook knows about you and your friends

### Learning Objectives:

Discover what Facebook knows about you and your friends thru an app. Discuss and analyze the information as well as privacy, integrity etc. within social media such as Facebook.

### Pedagogical Approaches and Activities:

Use this site to see how much information you and your friends are giving away to Facebook. We give enormous amounts of information to social sites like Facebook. Using this page to see your personal analytics of you and your friends – their names, age, location, sexual orientation, religious belief, political views – is all something we give in exchange for being part of a social network like Facebook. So use this and then discuss: Why does Facebook need all this information? What does it do with the information it gathers? Is it possible to be a part of a social network without giving out all this information? Can you regulate it thru privacy settings? Let the students read the Terms of Service with Facebook and discuss if they are aware of all the terms they agree to by signing up? What happens if you are not on Facebook?
